## Monthly Lawn Maintenance Guide Suggested by Local Nursery

**January** – P.H. & Soil Tests – Correct with Pelletized Dolomitic Lime

**February** – Hi-Yield Crabgrass Control – Revive Grass Clippings & Thatch Decomposer

**March** – Hi-Yield 5% Diazinon Insecticide Granules – Weed & Feed with Atrazine for St. Augustine Grass. For Bahia Grass use Hi-Yield Weed Out with Trimec.

**April** – Spot Spray weeds in St. Augustine Grass with Liquid Atrazine.  
Spot Spray weed in Bahia Grass with Liquid Trimec, 2-4D.

**May** – Lawn Food – S.A. Deltamethrin Insecticide – Delta 8 (May be premixed with fertilizer)

**June** – Hi-Yield Systemic Fungicide – Granules with Bayleton

**July** – Growth Stimulators (Fertilizer) with Iron & Insecticide Granules

**August** – Liquid Contact Fungicide

**September** – A Hi-Yield 5% Diazinon Insecticide Granules & a Growth Stimulator (Fertilizer) with Iron **if you do not have weeds/Weed and Feed if you do have weeds.**

**October** – Winterize

**November** – Hi-Yield Insecticide

**December** – Maintenance Free Month ☺
